Greetings in our Lord's precious name. Thank you for standing with us and praying for, and with us—"But when he saw the multitudes, he was moved with compassion on them, because they fainted, and were scattered abroad, as sheep having no shepherd. Then saith he unto his disciples, The harvest truly is plenteous, but the labourers are few; Pray ye therefore the Lord of the harvest, that he will send forth labourers into his harvest." (Mat. 9:36-38) I was out door-to-door the other day and was speaking to a man and woman about the Lord—the sin, the pain, the darkness, the despair in their lives. Pray! Pray for more labourers. Pray the Word have free course, and that we would be effective by God's Grace according to His Word.

Over these past two months our work has continued. The Lord has given liberty as we preach against sin and preach Christ crucified. Two weeks ago in our men's Bible Study the Lord brought the teaching to a head that the Bible is THE SOLE AUTHORITY, that faith is by the Word, and that we know the will of God as we walk by God's Word, proving what is that good, and acceptable will of God, as opposed to feelings, experiences, and charismatic spiritual wickedness—such as tongues, visions, and prophecies. Pray for Mark. A dear man, a Canadian Armed Forces veteran, who I was able to confront directly with his error. Pray that he hears, believes, and separates. Mark thinks he is saved, but the charismatic gospel is a false gospel—pray that the Lord would open his understanding. A week after this exposure of Mark's error he called and expressed that he is thankful God has brought us into his life. I pray that this expressed gratitude is genuine, which will be proved by his separating from his error and to the truth. The Word of God always divides between truth and lie, sin and righteousness, profane and holy, and unclean and clean.

Thank you for praying of Joey, mentioned in our previous letter. It is heart breaking to have to report to you that Joey has left off coming to Bible meetings to hear the preaching of the Word. I still have some contact with him, but he has turned away from us.
